### **FIRE PROTECTION TECHNICIAN**

A vacancy exists in the Company for the position of **Fire Protection Technician**.

#### **The Position**

This job is located within the Safety & Environment Department with responsibility for the maintenance of firewater pumps and drives, sprinkler and emergency alarm systems and all auxiliary equipment. Knowledge of mechanical and electrical servicing and installation procedures for fire protection equipment and the use of specialized tools are needed. Works under limited supervision and follows established guidelines and procedures. Supervision of non-contract and contract workers.

#### **Responsibilities of the position include, but are not limited to, the following:**

- Repairing and overhauling pumps, motors, and auxiliary equipment. This includes the assembly/disassembly, installation, inspection, reconditioning and replacement of pumps, motors, smoke and thermal detectors and other equipment components;
- Maintaining and repairing emergency alarm equipment and auxiliaries such as control panels and pull stations by interpreting schematic diagrams, testing, calibrating, and installing electrical components;
- Maintaining pipe work of firewater protection systems by providing regular lubrication, priming and painting;
- Performing regular test/runs of emergency protection equipment including firewater pumps and emergency alarms;
- Preparing reports with regards to the performance of equipment. This include reports such as defects report and performance statistics;
- Assisting with training and instruction on fire emergency equipment;
- Performing a variety of other related duties such as organize work schedules and gather parts.

#### **Job requirements include:**

- The completion of a Technical School Program with an Ordinary Technician Diploma and a Fire Protection Certificate.
- A minimum of five (5) years' experience or equivalent.
- Basic knowledge of mechanical and electrical schematics, circuitry and equipment.
- Good verbal and written skills.
- Familiarity with the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Codes.
