The Government of The Bahamas (the “Borrower”) has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) (the “Bank”) toward the cost of the project **BH-L1057 – Support the Improvement of the Electricity Service in The Bahamas**. The **Bahamas Power and Light (BPL)**, an executing agency of the Borrower, intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this loan to eligible payments under the contract for this service.

Applications are invited for a suitably qualified and experienced individual for the position of **Technical Engineering Specialist of the PEU**.

The principal duties and responsibilities of the position include but are not limited to the following: Manage technical directions for implementation of the project, working with other PEU staff and consultants. The TE will also interact with all stakeholders related to the project. The role reviews all major project execution documents such as the loan agreement, results matrix, procurement plan, PEP, PMR targets, and progress and audit reports to provide recommendations to the Project Manager.

The successful candidate should have the following skills:

■ **Education:** At least a Master's degree in engineering, science, renewable energy technology, environmental management or related engineering discipline or equivalent qualification. Or a Bachelor of Science Degree in Engineering with a least 5 years of utility experience.

■ **Experience:** at least 7 years of energy or engineer related experience and be a licensed engineer. Additionally, previous supervisory experience of at least 2 years for utility construction installations and a Certification in Project Management, and advanced certification in renewable energy projects, or related field will be an asset. Advanced working experience in the use of MS Suite e.g., Word, Excel, Visio, Access, Teams, Power BI, Microsoft SharePoint, SAP, Microsoft Projects/Project Online, renewable energy system modelling tools and software.

■ **Experience** with developing technical documents, technical specifications for bidding documents, and conducting technical evaluations of bids for review.

■ **Languages:** Advanced writing, communication, and presentation skills in English

Duration: One (1) year full-time, renewable.
