ELECTRICIAN - FACILITIES

A vacancy exists within the Company for the position of **Electrician** in the **Facilities Department, Field Operations Division**.

The Position

This job is located within the Facilities Department with primary responsibility for maintaining the reliability, safety, and continuous operation of electrical infrastructure across company facilities and properties. The Electrician – Facilities performs installation, maintenance, inspection, and repair of electrical distribution systems, lighting systems, and related equipment to ensure efficient facility operations and minimize service interruptions.
